November 15 CM Registration ends

All teachers should have registered their students by now on-line. DO NOT WAIT until the last minute. You need to time to check for mistakes and fix them. November is your time you go back to check on your work, before you send in the check.

Remember, I cannot help you after November 15. All mistakes are final. The computer shuts down on me too, so I can't go into the records and fix your mistakes.

You must send four things to Frances before November 15. The students fees list, the student fees page, your check to pay for the fees, AND your teacher work agreement. If we do not receive those four things BY November 15, your registration will not be accepted. **This is the rule of the CM council. There will be no exceptions.**

To print the student fees list, *go to Teacher Home Page.*

Click on *Student Fees List Print this page. Send this with your check.*

Below, "CM 2010 Student Fees", you will find a box that says "List Path A Students Go

If you click on go, you will get a really neat break down of your students by level with their fee. *PRINT THESE PAGES. Send this with your check.*

Then go back to the Student Fees List. If you click on the "List Path A Students" box, you will see "List Path B Students" *PRINT THESE PAGES. Send this with your check.*

The teacher work agreement is the green two sided document found in your September packet. Fill it out completely. Sign it. Send this with your check.

That's four things.

If you send *the Student List* instead, that's okay for this year. Next year, it will not be okay.
